Selection

SFDWP's is primarily a social group which happens to have a cricket team too. As such we value participation at the nets and pub as much as we value cricket prowess (which is lucky given the standard).

Players who attend nets regularly (and pay kit subs) will be chosen before occasional attendees or those people who only want to play outdoors... assuming that regulars respond to availability requests suitably promptly.

Kit

We'll supply enough quality kit (with the exception of boxes) for all and will ask for contributions from all players for this. Currently we're looking at a £20 subs/kit fee for 2009 to get enough kit for matches. We'll also hold some of the better equipment back for outdoor play next year and use the kit we've purchased over the past few years for indoor nets.

Match fees

These will normally be £5 per game for those who've paid the subs/kit fee or £8 for those occasional players who use the club-kit. If the regular match fee changes, the non-sub/kit fee will be 'plus £3' of whatever it works out at.

Workload and Admin

As yet (and hopefully for ever) we don't have fixture secretaries, chairmen, * treasurers etc, etc. As such we need everyone to participate in the running of the club including: emailing for availabilities; carrying / collecting kit bags; putting stumps and markers out; captaining; umpiring; scoring; subs collection; copying the oppositions scorebook; match-write-ups and of course; remembering 11 drinks and getting them in with the kitty. As the saying goes, many hands make a teenage groper-light work and those who shirk their responsibilities may be whispered about, with possible tutting!
